Southeast quarter (SE\(\frac{1}{2}\)) of Section seventeen (17), Lot one (1), East half of Northwest quarter (E\(\frac{1}{2}\)N\(\frac{1}{2}\)) of Section twenty-one (21), Lots one (1), two (2), three (3), North half (N\(\frac{1}{2}\)), East half of Southwest quarter E\(\frac{1}{2}\)SW\(\frac{1}{2}\)), Southeast quarter (SE\(\frac{1}{2}\)) of Section twenty-nine (29), in Township ten (10) North of Range six (6) East of the Willamette Meridian, excepting, however, from said Lot two (2) the 2.03-acre tract of land conveyed by the Northern Pacific Railway Company to the United States of Amorrica by deed dated December 27, 1927.

And the said party of the first part hereby covenants and agrees with the said party of the second part that the said several grantees of the said party of the second part shall hold the respective pieces and parcels of land so conveyed to them by the said party of the second part free and clear and discharged from the lien and encumbrance of said mortgage, and the payment of the sum or sums of money therein expressed, and every part thereof.
