RIGHT-0F-WAY DEED (road or trail)

THIS INDENTURE, made the twenty seventh day of May in the year one thousand nine hundred and Thirty-three, between Ole Peterson of the County of Skamania State of Washington, granter, party of the first part, and the Secretary of Agriculture of the United States Department of Agriculture for and in behalf of the United States of America, grantee, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH:

That for and in consideration of one dollar (\$1) in hand paid, receipt whereof is hereby duly adknowledged, the party of the first part does hereby grant, bargain, sell convey, and confirm unto the United States of America, an easement and right of way in gross over the following tract, lot, piece, or parcel, of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington, and bounded and particularly described as follows:

Lots 3 and 4, Section 29, Township 7 N., Range 5 E.

The road is to follow the Original Survey

The said right of way hereby granted is for the maintenance, and full, free, and quiet use and enjoyment by the United States of America for any and all purposes by them desired or deemed necessary or beneficial for or in connection with the control, administration, or use of the National Forests or the resources thereof, and, so far as may be with that enjoyment compatible, by the general public as a public highway being forty feet in width, and traversing the above described premises according to the following general course and direction, to wit:

General east and west direction

This grant shall be effective only so long as said easement shall be actually used for any of the purposes above specified, but all rights hereunder shall revert to the owner of the fee as soon as the said use thereof shall be abandoned and discontinued.

The grantee shall at all reasonable times have the right to enter for the purpose of constructing, repairing, and patrolling said right of way, doing as little damage as possible.
