O. C. Larsen et al. to State of Washington.

In the Matter of State Road No. 8, Underwood-West.

Know All Men by these presents, That O. C. Larsen, Frank Larsen, Amos Larsen, Phillip Aaron Larsen, Lewis Larsen, Nora Larsen Bolle heirs of C. E. and Mary Larsen, deceased, intestate, his wife, of the County of Skamania in the State of Washington, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of Eleven hundred fifty dollars, in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have GRANTED, BARGAINED, SOLD and CONVEYED, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the State of Washington, the following described parcel of land situated in Skamania County, in the State of Washington, to-wit:

A strip of land 100 feet wide (except as may be hereinafter specified) being 50 feet wide on the northward side of the center line of said road as surveyed, except on southward side from Engineering Survey Station 640 plus 87.4 eastward to the east line of Section 21, Township 3 North, range 10 East W. M., said strip of land is 70 feet wide, measured from the center line of said State Road No. 8, Underwood-West, as surveyed, over and across that portion of Government Lots 1, 2 and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, township 3 north, range 10 east of the Willamette Meridian; described as follows:

Beginning at a point 2640 feet north and 1156 feet east of the quarter section corner between sections 21 and 28, in township 3 north, range 10 E. W. M.; thence 1484 feet east; thence south 1650 feet; thence south 65° west 1485 feet; thence South 24° west, 284 feet; thence south 33° West 53.6 feet; thence north 2595 feet to the point of beginning, except the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, except county road, except right of way of the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Company and except following described tract owned individually by Phillip Aaron Larsen:

That portion of Gov. Lot 2 and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, township 3 North, Range 10 E. W. M., commencing at the point of intersection of the north line of county road, as now constructed, through said lot 2, with the east line of said section 21; thence north, along said section line, 90 feet, more or less to a small creek; thence southwesterly along the said creek, to the north line of said county road; thence easterly, 100 feet, more or less, along the north line of said road to the point of beginning. It being the intent hereby, that the said creek shall form the northerly and westerly boundaries of the tract hereby conveyed.

Grantees shall provide an approach for farm road on each side of said right of way strip; and shall permit grantors to place two water pipe lines for water supply and irrigation purposes across said right of way.

the specific details concerning all of which are to be found within that certain map of definite location now of record and on file in the office of the Director of Highways at Olympia and bearing date of approval January 23, 1934.
