WITNESSETH, That whereas, at a public sale of real property, held on the of 29th day/October, 1932, pursuant to an order of the Board of County Commissioners of Skamania County, State of Washington, duly made and entered, and after having first given due notice of the time and place and terms of said sale as required by the Laws of the State of Washington, the sum of One Hundred Twenty Dollars was the highest bid received at the aforesaid sale, for the following described real property, to-wit:

For and in consideration of the aforesaid sum of One Hundred-Twenty-Dollars, the County of Skamania, vendor, by and through its Treasurer, hereby agrees to sell and convey to Ben Bunch, vendee, his heirs and assigns, forever, the above described real property subjecto to the following conditions.
