W. M., shall be a north and south line determined by and directly between two markers consisting of 12 galvanized iron pipes, the first of which is at or near the south line of said section 24 and 3,960 feet, more or less, west of the generally recognized and accepted corner post marking the southeast corner of said section 24, said iron pipe being established at a point from which a fir tree 24" in diameter bears south 70 degrees west 36.7 feet, and a fir tree 18" in diameter bears North 252 degrees west 25.0 feet; and the second of said iron pipes being 1,320 feet north from the first of said iron pipes and set at a point from which a nail in the center of a fir stump 30" in diameter and 36" high bears south 45 degrees west 6 feet and a fir tree 18" in diameter bears North 63 degrees east 4 feet.
