Mattison and Esther Mattison, husband and wife; Harry M. Stearns and Jane Doe Steanrs, husband and wife; George S. Moody and Jane Doe Moody, husband and wife, and Skamania County National Farm Loan Association, a corporation, defendants:

That the object of said action is to foreclose a mortgage executed by Bernard A. Haffey to The Federal Land Bank of Spokane, for the sum of \$2000.00, dated January 15, 1918, which mortgage is recorded in the office of the County Auditor of Skamania County, Washington, in Book "Q" of Mortgages, page 52.

The further object of said action is to foreclose and bar the rights of the defendants and each of them, and all persons claiming by, through or under them or any of them, in and to said real property or any part thereof.
