A strip of land being all those portions of Government Lots Numbered 4 and 5 Section 30, township 3 North, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian that lie southwardly from and adjoin right of way of the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Company and northwardly from a line, parallel with and distant 70 feet southwardly (measured at right angles) from the center line of State Road No. 8, Cook-East to Underwood-West, as surveyed over and across said premises:
