Victor Scanavino to State of Washington

In the matter of State Road No. 8, Underwood Vicinity.

The undersigned, Victor Scanavino of the County of Skamania, State of Washington in consideration of the sum of Fifty and 00/100 Dollars in hand paid to him, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby release the State of Washington from any and all damages that may accrue because of the interruption or permanent discontinuance of water supply for dwellings of the undersigned. from a spring hereby designated as "Goddard Spring", resulting from the construction of State Road No. 8 Underwood-Vicinity over and across:

A portion of Government Lot No. 4, lying northwardly from Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Company's right of way, also over and across a portion of the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Company's right of way in Section 22, township 3 north, range 10 east of the Willamette Meridian. Said tract of land and rights to use of spring, now existing on said right of way belong to Minnie McCracken Goddard and Elizabeth Frances Goddard who have for many years furnished water for undersigned's dwellings.

It is understood and agreed that the undersigned may have temporary use of water if any is available without charge during the grading of said highway, or until he may obtain a supply from other sources. Such use shall be obtained at the expense of the undersigned and at his risk without interference with the construction and maintenance of said highway. Abbve temporary use refers to waters from Goddard spring for which use monthly rate of \$1.50 shall not be charged during grading.
