Ruth Cain to State of Washington

In the matter of State road No. 8 Underwood - Vicinity.

The undersigned, Ruth Cain of the County of Skamania, State of Washington, in consideration of the sum of Twenty and 00/100 Dollars in hand paid to her, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby release the State of Washington from any and all damages that may accrue because of the interruption or permanent discontinuance of water supply for dwelling of the undersigned from a spring hereby designated as "Goddard Spring" resulting from the construction of State Road No. 8, Underwood-Vicinity, over and across:

A portion of Government Lot No. 4, lying northwardly from the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Ry. Co's right of way, in Section 22, township 3 north, range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian. Said tract of land and rights to use of spring, now existing on said right of way, belong to Minnie McCracken Goddard and Elizabeth Frances Goddard who have for many years furnished water for undersigned's dwelling.

It is understood and agreed that the undersigned may have temporary use of water, if any is available from said spring, during the grading of said highway, or until she may be able to obtain a supply from other sources. Such use shall be obtained at the expense of the undersigned and at her risk, without interference with the construction and maintenance of said highway. Above temporary use refers to waters from "Goddard Spring" for which use monthly rate of \$1.50 shall not be charged during grading.
