A portion of Government Lot no. 4, lying northwardly from the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Ry. Co's right of way, also over and across a portion of the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Ry. Co's right of way, in section 22, township 3 North, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian. Said tract of land and rights to use of spring now existing on said right of way, belong to Minnie McCracken Goddard and Elizabeth Frances Goddard who have for many years furnished water for undersigned's dwelling.

It is understood and agreed that the undersigned may have temporary use of water, if any is available, without charge during the grading of said highway or until he may be able to obtain a supply from other sources.
