Beginning at a point 238.5 feet north of a point 47.266 chains south and 29.015 chains west of the northeast corner of the Amos M. Short D. L. C., and running thence north 60 feet, more or less, to the south line of west 15th street in the city of Vancouver, Washington, as now laid out and established; thence west, following the south line of said west 15th street, 97.5 feet, more or less, to the east line of Harney Street; thence south, along said east line of said Harney Street, 60 feet, more or less, to a point due west of the point of beginning; and thence east 97.5 feet to the place of beginning, the same being unplatted land in the city of Vancouver, Washington, and being designated on the treasurer's books of Clark County, Washington, as #162 of the east half of the Short D. L. C.

Hutton and Elsie D. Hutton, husband and wife, to Harry L. Craig and wife, said deed being recorded in book "176" at page 210 thereof, record of deeds of Clark County, Washington; thence north along the east boundary of said Craig tract to the point of beginning, the same being designated upon treasurer's books of Clark County, Washington, as #74 of the John W. Nye D. L. C.
