A strip of land being all those portions of following described tracts of land that lie northwardly from a line, parallel with and distant 80 feet southwardly (measured at right angles) from the center line of said State Road No. 8, Cook East to Underwood West, as surveyed over and across that portion of Government Lots numbered 3 and 4 of section 29, township 3 north range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, lying southwardly of the Spokane Portland & Seattle R.
