said railway at railway engineer's old station 230+00 equals railway engineer's relocation station 2086+83.0, and runs northeasterly to end opposite and at right angles to the center line of said railway at railway engineer's old station 174+00 equals railway engineer's relocation station 2141+96.3, containing approximately 0.83 acres, more or less.

And Whereas in consideration of the foregoing improvements having been made by the government along and upon said strip of land, as above set forth, the State of Washington in so far as it legally may, does hereby grant to the United States Government and to its assigns, a perpetual easement over the said seven foot strip of land hereinabove described, for the purpose of constructing and maintaining said retaining wall, and for right of way for telephone and telegraph lines. This easement is granted subject to the easement or right of the Skamania County Telephone Company which now occupies such strip, and also subject to the rights of such other public telephone utilities as may hereafter make application in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington to use such strip. Any occupancy by public telephone utilities hereafter applying for permission to occupy such strip to be limited to such common user agreement, as may be entered into between such public telephone utility and the United States of America or its assigns.

L. G. Bruhn to Louis VonSalzer

This Indenture, made this 24 day of July in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and thirty-five between L. G. Bruhn the party of the first part, and Louis Von Salzer the party of the second part:

Witnesseth; that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollars, lawful money of the United States, to her in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents, REMISE, RELEASE and forever QUIT CLAIM unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns all right, title, interest and estate of said party Quartz Mining Claim in and to certain piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

The undivided 1/8 interest to that certain mining claim known as the Hendy Lode Claim situated in the Niggerhead mining District on Camp Creek a tributary of McCoy Creek more particularly described as in Book "F" Mining location; page 568 records of mining of said county.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversion and reversion, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof.

To Have and To Hold all and singular the said premises, together with the appurtenances, unto said party of the second part and to her heirs and assigns forever.
