Affidavit of James Shepard

I, James Shepard, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am the son of Henry Shepard and Lucinda N. Shepard, grantees in that certain patent dated May 6, 1882, and recorded June 17, 1893, in Book "A" of Patents, page 21, Records of Skamania County, Washington;

That I am the same person who made that certain affidavit dated October 19, 1917, which was recorded October 20, 1917, in Book "Q" of Deeds, page 303, Records of Skamania County, Washington.

I further state that I am the James Shepard, who, with my wife, S. M. Shepard, and my brother, R. N. Shepard, on October 23, 1900, by warranty deed (which was recorded on November 2, 1900, in Book "Q" of Deeds, page 154, Records of Skamania County, Washington) conveyed to Peter Olson the following described lands and premises:

"The S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Henry Shepard Donation Land Claim, except, however, the cemetery, 40 x 60 feet, and certain parcels of land heretofore deeded to the following named persons:

- 25 acres to the Stevenson Land Co.,
- 2 acres to E. R. Linville,
- 29 acres to William Shepard
- 1 acre to Skamania County,
- 1 acre to Columbus Fields,
- 5 acres to Joseph Babbington,
- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres to William Kirkman."

The cemetery, 40 x 60 feet, above mentioned, is my family cemetery, which lies in Block 1, Riverview Addition to Stevenson, and is the only cemetery in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Shepard Donation Land Claim which was granted by patent as above mentioned.
