KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the Mt. St. Helens Consolidated Mining Company of Portland, Oregon, a corporation under the laws of said state, in consideration of Ten Dollars to it in hand paid by Wayne W. Coe, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said Wayne W. Coe his successors and assigns forever, all the following described real property situated in the County of Skemania and State of Washington, to-wit:

That certain tract described in the deed of the Mt. St. Helens Consolidated Mining Company to E. L. Harmon dated August 16, 1912, appearing of record in Book C. of Deeds at page 60 in the office of the County Auditor of said Skamania County, Washington, with the water rights and privileges included in said deed, and subject to the mineral reservation in favor of the grantor therein as set forth in said deed same being more particularly described in said deed as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner (being corner No. 3) of the Falls Lode Mining Claim, the same being the Northwest corner (corner No. 2) of the Spirit Lake Lode Mining Claim and being located on the edge of the water at the East shore of Spirit Lake, thence South 13° 39' West 172.6 feet, thence North 88° 28' East 337.4 feet, thence North 13° 39' East 172.8 feet to a point in the South line of the Falls Lode Mining Claim and North line of the Spirit Lake Lode Mining Claim, thence North 4° 3' West 323.47 feet, thence South 88° 28' West 500 feet to a point at the mouth of the creek on Harmony Point which bears South 44° 34' West 23.2 feet from the United States location monument No. 7, thence South 29° 54' East 367.2 feet to the point of beginning, containing 5 acres more or less and being a part of the Spirit Lake Lode Mining Claim and part of the Falls Lode Mining Claim in the St. Helens Mining District in Section 12, Township 9 North, Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian, in the above county and state.
