in, and the State of Washington being represented by DeWitt Jones, Deputy Prosecuting Att-
orney of Clark County, Washington; the Court having entered Findings of Fact and conclusions
of Law,

HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGES AND DECREES as follows, to-wit:

1. That Plaintiff be, and is hereby, given an Interlocutory Decree of Divorce from
Defendant upon the ground of the failure of said Defendant to properly care for and support
Plaintiff and the minor child of these parties and upon the ground of cruel and inhuman
treatment; that upon the expiration of six months from the entry hereof, a Final Decree of
Divorce enter herein, finally and completely dissolving and terminating the marriage relat-
ionship heretofore existing between said parties.

2. That Plaintiff be, and she is hereby, given the care, custody and control of Bever-
ly May Wilson, the minor child of said parties, subject to the right of Defendant to visit
said child at reasonable times and places.

3. That Defendant is hereby ordered and directed to pay to Plaintiff the sum of \$25.00
per month for the care and support of said child.

4. That there is hereby set aside to Plaintiff as her separate and individual property
the interest of said parties in the following described real property, situated in Skamania
County, Washington, to-wit: Lot 13, Block 1, Bonnevista Addition to North Bonneville, to-
gether with the dwelling situated thereon; the Chevrolet Coupe Automobile being purchased
by her, and the clothing and personal effects of herself and said minor child and all of
the household furniture of said parties, except a radio and desk.

5. That there be, and hereby is, set aside to Defendant the interest of said parties
in and to the following described real property, situated in Clark County, Washington, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 3.645 chains West of the Northeast corner of Lot 5 of the parti-
tion of the John Peter Bersch Estate, situate in Section 15 in Township 2 North of Range
2 East of the Willamette Meridian, and running thence West along the North line of said
Lot 5, 2.521 chains, more or less, to the Northeast corner of that certain 7 1/3 acre
tract deeded by grantor to J. S. Walters, et ux, October 20, 1931; thence South along
the Easterly line of said 7 1/3 acre tract, to the Southeast corner thereof; thence
East 2.521 chains to a point due South of the place of beginning; thence North 11.90
chains, more or less, to the place of beginning, containing 3 acres;

and real property situated in Skamania County, to-wit: (Lots 1 and 2, Block 4, Bonnevista
Addition to North Bonneville;) a Buick Coupe automobile being purchased by Defendant, his
clothing and personal effects and a radio and desk.

6. That the Defendant shall pay all community bills and obligations owing by said par-
ties.

7. That the Defendant shall pay to Plaintiff's attorneys the sum of \$50.00 for their
services herein, and shall pay the costs and disbursements herein to be taxed.
