EXECUTION

The State of Washington to the Sheriff of Skamania County, Greeting:

WHEREAS, R.J. Higdon, recovered judgment against Florence M. Middleton, formerly known as Florence M. Garwood in the said Superior Court, holding terms at Stevenson in said County and State, on the 19th day of July, 1934, for the sum of One Hundred and no/100 Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of 8 per cent per annum from May 19, 1933 until paid, and costs of suit, amounting to \$8.60 and \$50.00 attorney's fees, and in said action certain property was sold, same being a mortgage foreclosure action, and the amount realized from said said being the amount of \$75.00 less the costs of said sale, amounting to \$21.25 leaving a net credit upon said judgment of \$53.75, less the taxes of \$9.10 leaving \$44.65 to credit upon said judgment, leaving a balance due upon said judgment of \$113.95 and interest from May 19, 1933 until paid at 8% per annum on \$100.00 from May 19, 1933 until paid;

THEREFORE, IN THE NAME OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, You are hereby commanded to levy upon, seize and take into execution the personal property of the said Florence M. Middleton formerly known as Florence M. Garwood in your County, subject to execution, sufficient to satisfy said judgment, interest and increased interest, cost and increased cost, and make sale thereof according to law; and if sufficient personal property cannot be found, then you are further commanded to make the amount of said judgment, interest and increased interest, cost and increased cost, out of any real property not exempt by law, and make return of this writ within sixty days from the date hereof.

Herein fail not, and have you then and there this writ.
