## SCHEDULE I

Commencing at station 47 \$\neq\$ 86 of the survey of Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Company's right of way (said point being south 52° 12' west 176 feet from intersection with center line of said survey with section line betw en sections 1 and 2 twp. 2. N. R. 7 E. W.
