SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON

PIONEER PRINT, STEVENSON, WASH.

The commissioners of Skamania County herewith deed, free from encumbrances, to the State of Washington, in accordance with provisions of Section 5812-3b Remington's Revised Statutes, the following described lands acquired by Skamania County through foreclosure of tax lines.

"Any lands heretofore acquired, or which may hereafter be acquired, by any county through foreclosure of tax liens, or otherwise, may be offered by such county to the State of Washington for forest lands, and if such lands come within the classification of lands described in section 3 of chapter 154, Laws of 1923, the state forest board may select any or all of the lands so offered to become a part of state forest lands; and upon such selection by the state forest board the board of county commissioners is authorized to deed such lands to the State of Washington for state forest lands; and upon such deed being made the commissioner of public lands shall be notified and enter and not upon the records of his office such lands in accordance with the provisions of section 9 of chapter 154, Laws of 1923.

"Such lands shall be held in trust and administered and protected by the said board under the provisions of chapter 154, Laws of 1923, or any amendments thereto. Any monies derived from the lease of such lands or from the sale of forest products, oils, gases, coal, minerals or fossils therefrom, shall be distributed as follows:

"(a) The expense incurred by the state for administration, reforestation and protection, shall be returned to the general fund of the state treasury.

"(b) Ten per centum thereof shall be placed in the forest development fund of the state treasury.

"(c) Any balance remaining shall be paid to the county in which the lands are located to be paid, distributed and pro-rated to the various funds in the same manner as general taxes are paid and distributed during the year of such payment.
