PIONEER PRINT, STEVENSON, WASH.

Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company to the State of Washington dated December 17, 1931, as bearing North seventy-seven degrees, fifty-one minutes East (N.77°51' E.);  
thence westerly and northwesterly on a curve to right, having a radius of one thousand four hundred thirty-two and five tenths (1432.5) feet and which is tangent at its point of beginning to the last described course, a distance of one thousand three hundred sixty-one and seven-tenths (1361.7) feet to a point;  
thence North forty-seven degrees thirty-three minutes West (N.47°33' W.) a distance of three hundred eleven and two tenths (311.2) feet to a point;  
Thence northwesterly on a curve to the left, having a radius of one thousand four hundred thirty-two and five-tenths (1432.5) feet and which is tangent at its point of beginning to the last described course a distance of three hundred fifty-seven and five tenths (357.5) feet to a point;  
thence North sixty-one degrees, fifty-one minutes West (N.61°51' W.) a distance of five hundred sixty-five (565) feet, more or less, to a point on the west line of said James M. Findley Donation Land Claim.
