hereby convey and warrant unto Ralph H. Hinds, a married man, and unto Gladys Gupatil, a
married woman, hereinafter referred to as the grantees, the following described real property
to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the northerly line of the Evergreen Highway which is North
79°51' West 50 feet from a point which is 1052.00 feet South and 915.68 feet West of
common corner of Sections 15, 16, 21 and 22 in Township 2 North of Range 7 East of
the Willamette Meridian, and running thence North 0°48' West 100 feet; thence North
79°51' West 50 feet; thence South 0°48' East 100 feet to the Northerly line of said
highway; thence South 79°51' East 50 feet to the place of beginning, being designated
as Lot 2, in Block 10, of the unrecorded plat of the town of North Bonneville, Skamania
County, Washington.
