## FLOWAGE EASEMENT

THIS INDENTURE, made this 27 day of March, 1936, between Joe Thomas, a competent Indian and a widower, hereinafter called the Grantor, and the United States of America, hereinafter called the Government, witnesseth:

THAT WHE REAS; the Government is constructing a dam across the Columbia River between the States of Oregon and Washington at Bonneville, Oregon, and upon the completion of said dam will operate and maintain aspillway, power house and ship lock; and

WHEREAS, under operating conditions, all lands abutting on either bank of said river from Bonneville to the Celilo Canal which are below the elevation of the backwater curve
