It is further understood between the vendor and the vendee that when the payments have been paid toge~~e~~ather with int~~e~~rest, that a warranty deed and title insurance will be made to the vendee.

It is futher understood and agreed that the title of the property above described re- mains in the vendor untill the same has been paid for in full according to the terms of this agreement, and this contract is to be considered a conditional contract of sale, and in case the vendee fails to make his payments, the vendor may elect to repossess its self of the property because of such failure to comply with the terms of this contract, and may retain such amounts as may be paid hereon by way of rentals for the use and occupation of the premises and by way of liquidated damages because of the vendee's breach of this agree- ment or may sue for the balance of the purchase price.

St is futher understood and agreed that in case it become necessary to maintain action to enforec collection of the payments due or to repossess the property, that a reasonable attorney's fee may be allowed in addition to the costs of such action.
