I, Margaret Locke Galligan, being first duly sworn, depose and say: That I am one of the grantors, who, on the 16th day of October, 1936, executed a flowage easement to the United States of America, wherein the consideration was \$2,000.00, said flowage easement covering the following described lands, to-wit:

All that portion of Lots 2, 3, 4 and 5 in Section 30, Township 3 North, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, lying south of the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Company's right of way and south of relocated State Highway No. 8, in Skamania County, Washington.

I further say that there are no vested or accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes, nor vested rights to ditches or reservoirs used in connection therewith, nor is said land subject to the vested right of a proprietor of a vein or lode to extract or remove ore therefrom, nor are there any rights of way on said lands for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States. I also say that there are no easements used by third persons in connection with vested or accrued water rights, nor are there any parties in possession not shown of record, nor are there any questions of survey or boundary disputes; also no mechanics' lien claims exist, nor has any one within the last six months performed any work or labor or furnished any material that would entitle said person to a mechanic's lien claim. I further say that the transmission lines of the Northwestern Electric Company are on high ground and are not within the area over which a flowage easement was granted to the United States of America. I also say that the flume of the Drano Flume and Lumber Company is not within the area to be flooded by the Bonneville Project. I also say that I am the same person designated as "Margaret L. Galligan nee Locke" in that certain warranty deed dated March 23, 1932 and recorded September 23, 1935 in Book "Y" of Deeds, page 323, Records of Skamania County, Washington, and that I was also designated as "Margaret Galligan" in that certain quitclaim deed dated July 8, 1930 and recorded September 23, 1935 in Book "Y" of Deeds, pages 323-4, Records of Skamania County, Washington.

I further say that I make this affidavit for the purpose of removing certain objections as pointed out in the Attorney General's opinion of December 2, 1936.
