I, Dan Crowley, being first duly sworn, depose and say: That I am one of the grantors, who, on November 9, 1936, executed a flowage easement in favor of the United States of America for the consideration of \$50.00, granting and conveying a perpetual flowage easement over a portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, Township 3 North, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, lying west of the center of Rock Creek; that no easements exist which are used by third persons in connection with vested and accrued water rights on said property; that there are no parties in possession not shown of record, nor are there any question of survey or boundary disputes; and that there are no mechanics' lien claims existing that affect said land, not show of record.

I further say that said land is not subject to any vested or accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes, nor are there any vested rights to ditches or reservoirs; that said land is not subject to the vested right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove ore therefrom, nor is said land subject to any vested rights reserved by the United States for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

I further say that the wagon road easement contained in those certain deeds recorded page 425, Records of Skamania County, Washington, and in Book "H" of Deeds, in Book "H" of Deeds, pages 548-9, Records of Skamania County, Washington, is not affected by the Bonneville Project, as said wagon road is on high land and not within the area to be flooded by said Bonneville Project.
