DEED OF TRUST

This deed of trust made the 25th day of May, 1932, by Erick Bylin, surviving spouse of Anna Bylin, deceased, grantor, to Victor Anderson and Ernest Bodine, grantees, as trustees for Oscar Bylin, beneficiary, witnesseth:

That said grantor, for the consideration and upon the trusts hereinafter set forth, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto said Victor Anderson and Ernest Bodine or to the survivor of them and to the successors and assigns of such survivor, all that real property in Skamania County, Washington described as NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec., 23, Township 3, North Range 8 E. W.M., ~~except a plot of ground 50 feet by 100 feet heretofore deeded to the~~ school district;
