I, Roy Wessels, being first duly sworn, depose and say: That I am the same person designated as Roy Wessels in that certain deed dated February 28, 1931, and recorded March 2, 1931, in Volume "W" of Deeds, page 586, Records of Skamania County, Washington, wherein I and my wife, Lella Wessels, were grantees and received title to Lots 17 to 21, inclusive, in Block 2 of Stevenson, according to the official plat thereof; also a strip of land 8 feet in width along the south side of said lots and a strip of land 30 feet in width along the west side of said Lot 17, said strips of land being vacated alley and street respectively; that said Lella Wessels was my wife on the 28th day of February, 1931, and is my wife at this time; and that I am the same Roy Wessels who, with my wife Lella Wessels, executed a Flowage Easement to the United States of America on the 22nd day of July, 1936, granting a perpetual flowage easement over a portion of the above described lands.
