sils except pressure cooker above-mentioned; floor lamp; all rocking chairs; clock; my large rug; book rack; all books; walnut dresser; all pictures except those belonging to my deceased wife; radio; magnifying glass; lounge; sewing machine; flower pots or jardiniere; heating stove; electric sweeper; electric heating pad; shot gun; stand; round stand table; two kerosene stoves; all fruit jars; all dishes; bond box.

FIFTH. I give, devise and bequeath to my nephew, Clarence Affolter, and my niece, Sarah Affolter, all of my bank stock in the Pioneer State Bank of Goldendale, Washington, to be divided equally between them, they to share and share alike.

SIXTH. I give, devise and bequeath to my beloved sister, Annie Buetow, all of the residue and remainder of the property of which I may die seized and possessed, whether real, personal or mixed, and wherever the same may be.

SEVENTH. I intentionally omit to make any devise or bequest to my adopted son, Ernest H. Taylor, for the reason that I consider that he has already received his just portion of my property.

EIGHTH. I nominate and appoint C. E. Crooks of Goldendale, Washington, executor of this my last will and testament. I direct that upon my death that he take immediate possession of all my property, whether real, personal or mixed, and that he manage or dispose of any or all of said property as he may deem best, and without any order of the court thereof, and for that purpose I hereby vest in him full power and authority to sell or convey any or all of said property, whether real, personal or mixed, and after paying all costs and expenses as provided in paragraph FIRST herein, to distribute the same in accordance with this my last will and testament.

NINTH. I especially direct that my estate shall be settled in the manner provided in this my last will and testament and that letters testamentary shall not be required other than to comply with the law, and that my estate shall be managed and settled without the intervention of any court other than what is necessary under the non-intervention law.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have signed, sealed, published and declared this my last will and testament at Goldendale, Klickitat County, State of Washington, this 20th day of February, 1936.
