I, Mary V. Lane, being first duly sworn, depose and say: That I was the grantor in that certain flowage easement wherein the United States of America was grantee, the same being dated April 25, 1937, said flowage easement covering lands in Lot 1, Section 23, Township 3 North, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington; That there are no vested or accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes, or rights to ditches or reservoirs used in connection therewith, nor is the said land over which I granted a flowage easement subject to the vested right of a proprietor of a wein or lode to extract and remove ore therefrom, nor are there any ditches or canals thereon constructed by the authority of the United States. I also say that there are no easements used by third persons in connection with vested or accrued water rights that affect said lands. I further say that there are no rights or claims of parties in possession of said lands over which I granted a flowage easement to the United States of America, not shown of record, nor are there any questions of survey existing that affect said lands.
