- 2. Any lien imposed by law by reason of the outstanding indebtedness of any drainage, irrigation or other special improvement district and any lien or encumbrance revived or place on said property by, through or under the party of the second part.
- 3. Any and all easements, rights of way for railroads, roads or highways or other servitudes, and the exceptions, provisions and reservations contained in patents or deeds from the United States of America, or the state in which said land is situate, or in deeds from railway companies.

The party of the first part hereby covenants that, except as hereinabove stated, it will forever Warrant and Defend the title to said premises and the quiet and peaceable possession thereof unto the said party of the secomd part, or her assigns, against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
