IN THE MATTER of Secondary State Highway No. 8 B., Washougal River to McPherson's Store.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Robert C. Prindle and Louisa A. Prindle his wife, of the County of Skamania in the State of Washington, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of Fifteen and 00/100 Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the State of Washington, the following described parcel of land situated in Skamania County, in the State of Washington, to-wit:

A strip of land 60 feet wide (except as may be hereinafter specified), being 30 feet wide on the northward side and 30 feet wide on the southward side of the center line of said highway as surveyed over and across the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ except the east 560 feet thereof lying southerly of existing highway, Section 5, Township 1 N., R. 5 E.W.M., except that on the northward side from Engineering Survey Station 609/50 to Engineering Survey Station 612/50 said strip of land is 40 feet wide and from Engineering Survey Sta. 593/00 to north line of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ on the southward side said strip of land is 40 feet wide, grantee shall provide for water pipe line at two points across right of way when needed,
