Clara C. Anderson to State of Washington

IN THE MATTER OF Secondary State Highway No 8-B, Washougal River to McPherson's Store.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Clara C. Anderson, a spinster of the County of Skamania in the State of Washington, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of One hundred seventy-five Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the State of Washington, the following described parcel of land situated in Skamania County, in the State of Washington, to-wit:

A strip of land 70 feet wide (except as may be hereinafter specified), being 40 feet wide on the northward side and 30 feet wide on the southward side of the center line of said highway except that on the southward side from Engineering Survey Station 678/50 to Engineering Survey Station 681 plus 00, said strip of land is 60 feet wide and on the northward side from Engineering Survey Station 672/00 to Engineering Survey Station 677/00, said strip of land is 50 feet wide as surveyed over and across the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 1 North, Range 5 E.W.M. except the west 40 feet thereof

the specific details concerning all of which are to be found within that certain map of definite location now of record and on file in the office of the Director of Highways at Olympia and bearing date of approval August 24th, 1937,

The State is released from any damage resulting from loss of spring.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, unto the State of Washington forever.

It is understood and agreed that the delivery of this deed is hereby tendered and such tender kept good until revoked but that the terms and obligations hereof shall not become binding upon the State of Washington unless and until accepted and approved hereon in writing for the State of Washington, Department of Highways, by the Right of Way Engineer.
