THIS DEED, EASEMENT and AGREEMENT, entered into this 5th day of January, 1938, by and between GLADYS T. REYNOLD and her husband, J. J. REYNOLDS, of Seattle, Washington, hereinafter known as the grantors, and the UNDERWOOD FRUIT & WAREHOUSE COMPANY, a Washington corporation, headquarters at Underwood, Washington; hereinafter known as the grantee, WITNESSETH:

That, WHEREAS, the grantors are the owners of the following described property,
