Motice Is Hereby Given that on the 10th day of February, 1938, the United States of America commenced an action against the Northwestern Electric Company, a Washington corporation, et al., in the District Court of the United States for the Western District of Washington, Southern Division, at Tacoma, Washington, for the condemnation of a flowage easement over defendants' lands in Government Lots 1 and 2, Section 23, hereinafter more particularly described, up to elevation 85.6 feet, and the remainder of defendants' lands in Section 23, as hereinafter described, and all of said defendants' lands in Section 14, hereinafter more particularly described, up to elevation 90.6 feet, said lands being in the bed of the White Salmon River and along the banks of said river, partly in Klickitet County, Washington, and partly in Skamania County, Washington, and being portions of the following described legal subdivisions:

That it is necessary to secure the easement over the above described lands in connection with the Construction by the United States of America of the dam, ship lock and power house at Bonneville, Oregon, which is ordinarily designated as the Bonneville Project.
