I, Raymond Bevans, being first duly sworn, depose and say: That I am the same person, who, with my wife, Alice J. Bevans, on the 31st day of August, 1936, executed a flowage easement to the United States of America for the consideration of \$500.00, covering Lots 5 and 6, Block 1 of the town of Stevenson, according to the official plat of record in the office of the County Auditor of Skamania County, Washington, together with all lands accruing thereto by reason of the vacation of abutting streets or alleys of said town of Stevenson; That there are no vested or accrued water rights affecting said lands; That there is no dispute as to right of possession of said lands and no parties other than the grantors of said flowage easement are in possession, or claim right of possession of said lands; That there are no questions of survey or disputes as to boundaries of said lands; That there are no mechanics' or other liens unrecorded, or claimed against said lands, and that said lands are free and clear of all liens.

I, Lyn Arnold, being first duly sworn, depose and say: That I am the person who, designated as a single man, executed a flowage easement to the United States of America for a consideration of \$1,250.00, said flowage easement being dated August 17, 1936, covering the following described lands, to-wit:

Lots 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, and 20 in Block 3, Stevenson, according to the duly recorded plat thereof on file in Skamania County, Washington;

That there are no vested or accrued water rights, ditch or reservoir rights used in connection with said lands existing by reason of local customs, laws and decisions; That there is no dispute as to the right of possession of said lands and no party other than myself, the grantor of said flowage easement, is in possession or claims right of possession of said land; That there are no questions of survey or disputes as to boundaries of said lands; That there are no mechanics' liens claimed against said lands.

I also say that I am at this time unmarried, and that I was unmarried on the date that I acquired the land over which I granted a flowage easement to the United States, and that during all times that I have owned said land I have been an unmarried man.

That I make this affidavit for the purpose of removing certain objections as pointed out in the Attorney General's opinion of September 4, 1936, relative to the above described
