### Dedication

First: Commences at the Northeast corner of lot 1 Plot of Underwood, or a course S 30° 07' W. 595.93 feet from the Southeast corner of said lot, thence S 83° 11' W. 531.83 feet to a point, thence S 6° 49' E. 115 feet, to the Northwest corner of lot 9, said Plot; thence N. 83° 11' E. 515.60 feet to the place of beginning.  
 Second: Commences at a point S. 0° 7' W. 60.43 feet from the Southeast corner of said lot 1; thence over S. 83° 11' W. 416.36 feet to a point; thence S. 6° 49' E. to the Columbia River; thence following the meanderings of said River up Stream, to a point, 100.72 feet S. 0° 7' W. from the place of beginning. thence N. 0° 7' E. 100.72 feet to the point of beginning. All land part of Fractional N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 23, Towns North Range 10 feet of N.W. in Skamania County, Wash.

The first tract consists of Block 1 and an Alley, divided into 10 lots, and lies North of lots 15 & 9 of the original Plot. The second tract consists of Block 2 and lies South of Main Street. The number and size of lots, and the courses and lengths of lines are shown on this plot.

And we do hereby file the within maps of the "First Addition to the Town of Underwood," dedicating to the uses of the Public forever an Alley 15 feet wide, and declaring said Plot to be our free act and deed.
