


Hamiltons Second Addition

Beginning at the S.W. corner of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 23, T.3N.R.10.E.W.M. Thence North 667.5 feet. Thence East 230 feet. Thence south 667.5 feet. Thence west 230 feet to the place of beginning thereby bounding block 1 & 2 in Hamiltons Second Addition to the town of Underwood.
