Interlaken Resort Co. to N.W.Electric Co.

In consideration of one dollar the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Interlaken Resort Company a corporation, grant to Northwestern Electric company a perpetual right of way in and over the following described real property situated in the county of Skamania state of Wash. to-wit: The Southwest half of the D.Baughman Donation Land claim No.42 in section 1 Township 2 north range 7 east of Willamette Meridian and the D.F.Bradford donation land claim No.37 in section 11 township 2 North of Range 7 East of Willamette Meridian excepting that part belonging to E.P.Ash and Nellie Ash, for the purpose of erecting maintaining and operating thereon two pole or tower lines for transmission of electric current, together with the right to cut and remove such trees and brush as may be necessary for the constructing maintaining and protecting such lines from damage. One transmission line commences at a point in the division line between the northeast half and the southwest half of the D.Baughman D.L.C. claim 115 feet northerly from the center line of the Spokane Portland & Seattle Railway Company right of way, thence in a southwesterly direction parallel to and 115 feet northerly from the center line of the Spokane Portland & Seattle Railway right of way to a point in the west line of the D.Baughman Donation Land claim. Commencing at a point where the above described line projected in a straight line enters the northeast boundary line of the D.F.Bradford D.L.C. thence in a straight line to a point in the southwest boundary of the Bradford donation Land claim 150 feet southerly from the quarter corner between sections 10 and 11, township 2 North of Range 7 East
