QUIT-CLAIM DEED

THE GRANTOR, EARL W. JACKSON, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) in hand paid, and other good and valuable consideration, conveys and quitclaims to YVONNE JACKSON, his wife, as her separate estate, all interest in the following described real estate, situate in the County of Skamania, State of Washington:

Starting at the Northwest quarter corner of the Northeast corner of Section 32, Township 2, North Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian, thence South 1660 feet to the center of the present County Road known as the Burns Road; thence Easterly along center of said road to a point which is 770 feet due East from said West line and 1290 feet South of the North line of said Section 32; thence Northeasterly following the center of said County Road to the North line of Section 32; thence West on said section line approximately 1320 feet to the true point of beginning.
