THIS INDENTURE, Made this 21st day of July A.D. 1945 between John C. Wachter, as Treasurer of the county of Skamania, State of Washington, party of the first part, and the County of Skamania State of Washington, party of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That, whereas, pursuant to a real estate tax judgment entered in the Superior Court of the County of Skamania State of Washington, on the second day of May, A.D. 1945, in proceedings to foreclosure tax liens upon real estate, wherein the county of Skamania State of Washington, was given a several judgement against each of the pieces parcels or tracts of land hereinafter mentioned for the amount set opposite thereto in the column headed "Amount of Judgement," and an order of sale duly issued by said Superior Court, a public sale of real estate was held on the 7th, day of July, A. D. 1945, at the front door of the Court House at Stevenson in said County, due and legal notice thereof first having been given according to law, at which there were no bidders offering to pay the amount of any of the hereinafter mentioned several judgments;
