

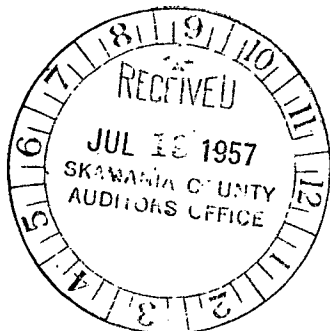
WARRANTY DEED

THE GRANTOR, MELLA CROWLEY, a widow, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars to her in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby convey and warrant unto NORMAN W. SENTER, ORVILLE E. BAILOR and CARL H. HANSEN, Worshipful Master, Senior Warden and Junior Warden, respectively, as trustees and to their successors in office, as a continuing board of trustees for Skamania Lodge No. 207, Free and Accepted Masons of Washington, that certain tract or parcel of real property situate in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the South line of Section 36, Township 3 North, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian and the West line of the Henry Shepard D.L.C.; thence East 115.8 feet; thence North $61^{\circ} 40'$ East 1557.1 feet to the intersection of the center line of Vancouver Avenue and the center line of Kanaka Creek road, which point is the initial point of the tract to be described; thence North $36^{\circ} 27'$ West along the center line of Kanaka Creek road to intersection with the center line of permanent highway No. 3, known as Loop road; thence following the center line of the said Loop road to intersection with the center of Vancouver Avenue; thence along the center line of Vancouver Avenue in an Easterly direction to the initial point. The tract of land hereby conveyed being that parcel of land lying between the Loop road on the North and Vancouver Avenue and Kanaka Creek road on the Southerly and Easterly side.

EXCEPTING therefrom that portion of the above mentioned highways lying within the bounds of the parcel hereby conveyed.

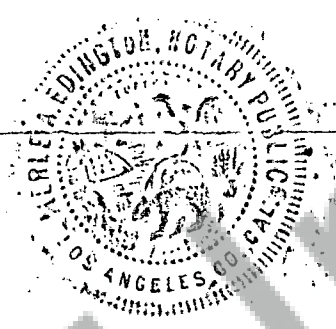
