

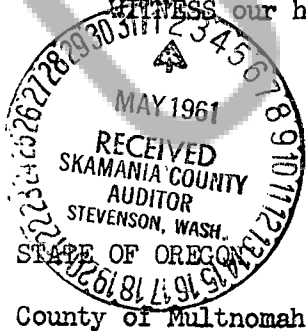
QUITCLAIM DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, JOHN T. KASPARI and JEAN KASPARI, husband and wife, in consideration of TEN AND NO/100 (\$10.00) DOLLARS, and other good and valuable consideration to us paid by Georgia-Pacific Investment Company, an Oregon Corporation, do hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said Georgia-Pacific Investment Company, an Oregon Corporation and unto its successors and assigns, all our right, title and interest in and to the following described real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances, situated in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

The South Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 9; the West Half of the Northeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), the North Half of the Southeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), the South Half of the Northwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), and Government Lots 1, 8, and 9, in Section 16; all in Township 2 North, Range 7 E. W. M.; EXCEPT the 300 foot strip of land acquired by the United States of America for the Bonneville Power Administration's electric power transmission lines and easements for access roads appurtenant thereto.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Georgia-Pacific Investment Company, an Oregon Corporation, its successors and assigns forever.
