It appearing to the Commissioner of Public Lands that Application No.  $2^{44}$  has been filed in this office by the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, Gifford Pinchot National Forest, hereinafter referred to as the Forest Service, for an easement for a right of way for a road over and across portions of Government Lot 1 and the  $NW_4^4$   $NE_7^4$ , Section 26, Township 7 North, Range 5 East, W.M.; and

It further appearing that this easement is necessary for the use of the Forest Service as a road; that there is merchantable timber on the area included within the right of way; that such timber has an appraised value of \$656.00; that said amount has been paid; and that the plat showing the survey of said right of way as filed with said application is hereby approved as the official plat of said road, it is therefore

ONDERED and DETERMINED, in accordance with the authority set forth in Section 5, Chapter 73, Session Laws of 1961, that an easement for right of way for a road is hereby granted to the Forest Service over and across the following described land:

Those portions of Government Lot I and the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Sectron 26, Township 7 North, Range 5 East, W.M., included within the limits of a strip of land of variable width on each side of the following described line:

Beginning at a point on the north line of said Section 26 which is S  $89^{\circ}$  03' 00" E 1395.47 feet from the northwest corner the reof and running thence with a width of 70 feet on the left and 50 feet on the right, S 29° 41′ E 162.69 feet, thence on a 4° curve to the right. 65.32 feet, continuing thence with a width of 80 feet on the left and 40 feet on the right, \$ 27° 01' 30" E 96.12 feet, thence on a 22° curve to the left, 75.42 feet, thence \$ 43° 37' E 98.71 feet, continuing thence with a width of 90 feet on the left and 40 feet on the right, 5 43° 37' E 76.17 feet, thence on an 18° curve to the left 156.72 feet, continuing thence with a width of 80 feet on the left and 40 feet on the right, \$ 71° 45' 35" E 100.72 feet, thence on a 22° curve to the right 55.20 feet, thence S  $59^\circ$   $41^\circ$  E 98.17 feet, thence on a  $22^\circ$  curve to the left, 21.62 feet, thence S  $64^\circ$   $26^\circ$   $25^\circ$  E 141.40 feet, continuing thence with a width of 105 feet on the left and 40 feet on the right, S 64° 26' 25" E 6.72 feet, thence on a 22° curve to the left 89.15 feet, thence S  $84^\circ$  03'  $10^\circ$  E 24.13 feet, continuing thence with a width of 80feet on the left and 40 feet on the right, \$ 84° 03' 10" E 25.02 feet, thence on a 22° curve to the right 99.97 feet, thence \$  $62^{\circ}$  03' 35" E 38.21 feet, continuing thence with a width of 120 feet on the left and 40 feet on the right, on a 22° curve to the left 96.80 feet, continuing thence with a width of 120 feet on the left and 80 feet on the right, on said 22° curve to the left, 121.56 feet, thence N  $69^{\circ}$  54' E 138.44 feet, continuing thence with a width of 60 feet on the left and 80 feet on the right, N 69° 54' E 240.00 feet, continuing thence with a width of 60 feet on the left and 40 feet on the right, N 69° 54' E 135.09

feet, thence on a 12° curve to the left, 64.91 feet, continuing thence with a width of 33 feet on the left and 40 feet on the right, on said 12° curve to the left 366.90 feet, thence N 18° 05' E 33.10 feet, continuing thence with a width of 33 feet on the left and 50 feet on the right, N 18° 05' E 100.00 feet, continuing thence with a width of 60 feet on the left and 50 feet on the right N 18° 05' E 50.00 feet, continuing thence with a width of 60 feet on the left and 40 feet on the right 161.15 feet, and continuing thence with a width of 80 feet on the left and 60 feet on the right, on a 16° curve to the right 6.30 feet to a point on the north line of said Section 26 which is N 89° 41' 25" E 988.11 feet from the north quarter section corner thereof, the tangent to said curve at said point bears N 19° 05' 29" E.

Except, however, any of the above described lands included within an easement for right of way granted to Pacific Power and Light Company, August 17, 1960, under Application No. 24876.

The above described rights of way contain a total area of 0.43 acre as shown on the plat thereof on file in the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands at Olympia, Washington.

Subject, however, to all rights and valid claims previously conveyed by the State of Washington in any of the above described lands.

Subject, however, to the following provisions:

- 1. Termination. The rights, privileges and authorities herein granted shall continue for as long as used for the purposes granted, but if the United States shall cease for a period of two years to use the rights, privileges and authorities for the purposes granted or shall abandon the use of the right of way herein granted, then the State may terminate the easement and all rights hereunder shall revert to the State of Washington.
- 2. The State of Washington reserves to itself the right to use, maintain, patrol, reconstruct and repair said roadway for any and all purposes deemed necessary or desirable in connection with the control, management, harvest and administration of state-owned lands or the resources thereof, in such manner as will not unreasonably interfere with the use of said road by the Grantee or its authorized users or cause substantial injury thereto; Provided, that during periods when the State of Washington or its assigns uses said road, it will perform its share of road maintenance on the portion so used or shall contribute to the cost of said maintenance so that its proportionate share of the cost of maintaining the road to the extent necessary to restore the road to the condition existing at the start of the use will be paid or performed.
- 3. The rights, privileges and authorities herein granted for full use and enjoyment of the Grantee for any and all purposes deemed necessary or desirable in connection with the control, management and administration of the national forests or the resources thereof, and insofar as compatible therewith, the Grantee may extend such rights and privileges to others, provided such use by others shall be controlled so it will not, in the opinion of the regional forester, interfere unduly with the use of the road by the State of Washington.
