Know all men by these presents that I Ann P. Hamlin of Sheffield in the county of Berkshire and Commonwealth of Massachusetts in consideration of Eight Thousand Dollars paid by Daniel F. Bradford of Cascades in the County of Skamania and Territory of Washington, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby remise release and forever Quit-claim unto the said Daniel F. his heirs and assigns all the right title and interest I have in and to the Land Claim resided upon by said Daniel F. for a more particular description of which reference may be had to the notification of said Daniel F. numbered One Hundred and sixty one (161) deposited in the office of the Surveyor General at Olympia in said territory meaning and intending hereby to discharge a certain mortgage heretofore given by said Daniel F. to me dated February 23d A.D. 1855 and recorded in the Registry in said Skamania County in Book A pages 7, 8, & 9.- to have and to hold the above released premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Daniel F. Bradford his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever. And I the said Ann P. Hamlin for myself and my Heirs, Executors, and Administrators do covenant with the said Daniel F. Bradford, his heirs and assigns that the premises are free from all incumbrances made or suffered by me. And that I will and my heirs, Executors, and administrators shall warrant and defend the same- to the said Daniel F. Bradford his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by through or under me., but against no other. In witness whereof I the said Ann P. Hamlin has hereunto set my hand and seal this 28th day of April in the Year of our Lord 1856.
