

J. P. Gillette to Oregon Lumber Co

In consideration of the Oregon Lumber Company, putting a Saw Mill on the west side of the Little White Salmon, Skamania County, Washington, and, for the further consideration of \$1000, to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof, I hereby acknowledge, I agree to sell after I make final proof at the rate of 25 cents per thousand feet - all merchantable timber, on my Homestead No 8584, in Section 15, Township 3, Range 9 East, W. M. Skamania County Washington, to be estimated, provided however, that said Company and I can agree on estimate. If timber is estimated, I agree to give to said Company, immediately after I make final proof, Bill of Sale for said timber, on land as described as above, and said Company, are to give me their note due in six months, for total amount of timber as per estimate at the above stated rate of 25 cents per thousand feet. It is further understood, and agreed to that if said company and I (not any men selected by us) cannot agree on an estimate of said timber, that I will sell at the same rate per thousand feet - Scale Measure, and any timber taken from above land and cut into timbers in any one month, to be paid for on or about the 20th, of the following month. Said Company, are to have the privilege of building any road or roads across my land necessary to get timber to their Saw Mill. Dated Dooms Washington
