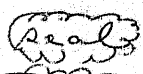
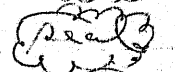


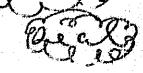
This Article of agreement made and entered into this 24th day of March A.D. 1888 by and between T. F. Lewis and S. B. Jones party of the first part and The Buckhite Packing Co. party of the second part.

Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the agreement hereinafter named to be performed by said party of the second part have agreed and do hereby undertake to sell to the said party of the second part all the Chinook Salmon Blue Backs Steelheads & silversides in good condition caught by a certain scow Tish which is used by said party of the first part during the fishing season of the year 1888 at the rate of two (2) cents per pound gross weight payment to be made on the 15th day of August.

In consideration of which the said party of the second part hereby agree to take the said fish and pay for the same as above set forth and to advance to the said party of the first part in cash not to exceed \$2500.00 towards repairing the said scow fish wheel and building one or ~~one~~ ^{two} leads for the same as witnessed whereof the parties hereto have set their hands and seals.
