Under Section 2290, Revised Statutes of the United States, I hereby agree to give to said Oregon Lumber Company, a Bill of Sale for all of the timber on the above described land and, guarantee to them an unmolested right to the same, I, to have whatever timber I need for fire wood and improvement on land as above described. Said Oregon Lumber Company to have privilege of building any logging road or roads necessary to get said timber to their Saw Mill,
