

William Kennedy to Oregon Lumber Co

In Consideration of the Oregon Lumber Company, putting a Saw Mill on the West Side of the Little White Salmon, Klamath County, Washington: And for the further consideration of \$100.00 to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge, I agree to sell to said Company, for 25 cents per thousand feet - Scale Measure, all timber on my Homestead, No 7864, (except cedar trees under benches at Bell) in Section 11, Township 3 Range 9 East, W.M., Klamath County, Washington. It is further understood and agreed, that if we can agree on estimate that said company and I will estimate timber on above described land, and that I am to be paid in full for timber as per such estimate, within six months after making final proof, at the same rate per thousand as if sealed. And I am to give to said company a bill of sale of said timber and guarantee to them an unmolested right to same. Said Company to have the privilege of building any road or roads across above described land, for the purpose of getting timber to their Mill. In case we are unable to agree on an estimate and the timber is sealed at Mill, I am to be paid on or about the 20th of each month for all timber cut into lumber the previous month.
