

Between J. W. Jamison & F. M. Luim & N. M. Eastwood
Article of Agreement

To all whom it may concern, This agreement made and entered into this the 21st day of April 1897 between J. W. Jamison & F. M. Luim of the first part, and N. M. Eastwood of the second part Witnesseth, That the above mentioned parties of the first part having located two mining claims known as the Pine Crow & the Cordelia do hereby agree with N. M. Eastwood of the second part to locate a third claim, and to perform one year or more of labor if necessary to open up or develop one claim known as the Pine Crow, all the above claims are situated in Look Out-mining Dist. in the County of Stansbury and State of Washington. Jamison, Luim and Eastwood, each to be entitled to one third's interest in each claim in consideration thereof, N. M. Eastwood party of the second part does hereby agree with the party of the first part to furnish Powder, fuse, caps, and all provisions including tobacco and money, and all Articles necessary for the prosecution of the aforesaid work or labor, the aforesaid claim to be located, to be known as the —
