Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Vancouver Washington, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To Secure Homestead to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Giovanni Gattanini has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the

South East Quarter of Section two in Township one North of Range five East of Willamette Meridian in Washington containing one hundred and sixty acres.

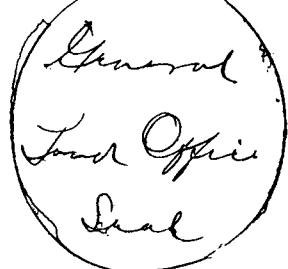
according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now know ye, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Giovanni Gattanini the tract of Land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Giovanni Gattanini and to his heirs and assigns forever; Subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of Court, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law

In Testimony Whereof J. Benjamin Harrison, President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed,
